Part I of IV In The: *Take Me on a Journey Series*

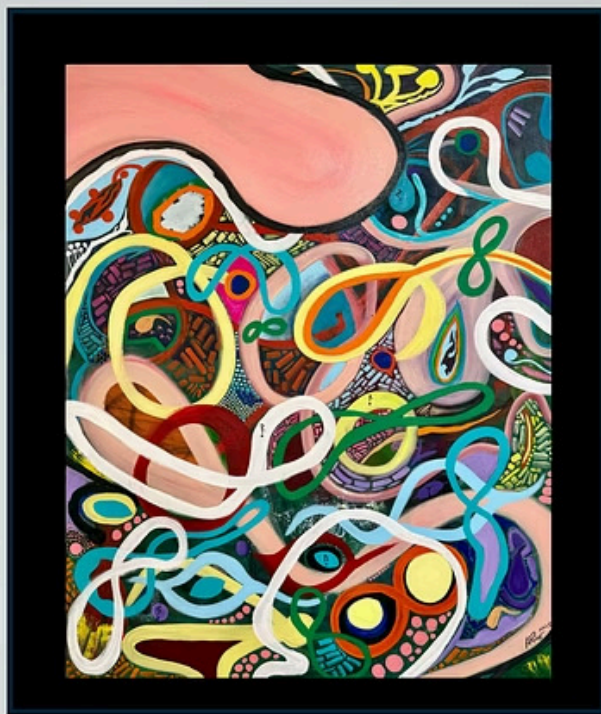

"Do You See What I See"

Part II of IV In The: *Take Me on a Journey Series*

Do You See What I See? continues the vibrant exploration of perception and perspective within the four-part series *Take Me On a Journey*. This work invites the viewer to look beyond the surface and to question what is seen versus what is felt. Layers of color, motion, and symbolism intertwine, creating a visual conversation between intuition and observation.

Through a kaleidoscope of abstract forms, fluid lines, and watchful eyes, the piece evokes the multiplicity of human awareness. It asks each viewer to pause, to interpret, and to connect – not only with the imagery but with their own inner vision.

This second installment deepens the narrative begun in *There's More to the Story*, guiding the observer into new dimensions of curiosity, emotion, and spiritual resonance. It is both an invitation and a mirror – urging the question: *Do you see what I see... or something entirely your own?*

"Bell Of Discernment"

The Bell of Discernment explores the quiet authority that emerges after life's trials — the kind of wisdom that cannot be taught, only earned.

The figure at the center bears visible marks of adversity — layered, disrupted, and imperfect — yet remains upright, present, and aware. His gaze reflects lived experience: a keen eye shaped by loss, endurance, faith, and healing. What once overwhelmed him now informs him.

The yellow boundary functions as a symbolic threshold — a bell that rings not with sound, but with clarity. It represents discernment: the moment when chaos no longer dictates direction, and awareness becomes protection. Within this space, the figure learns to listen differently — choosing what enters his spirit and what no longer serves him.

Music becomes a form of sanctuary. The headphones signify intentional focus, inner alignment, and self-preservation — a refusal to absorb external noise while healing is still underway. Though bruised, the figure is not broken. Though tested, he remains joyful.

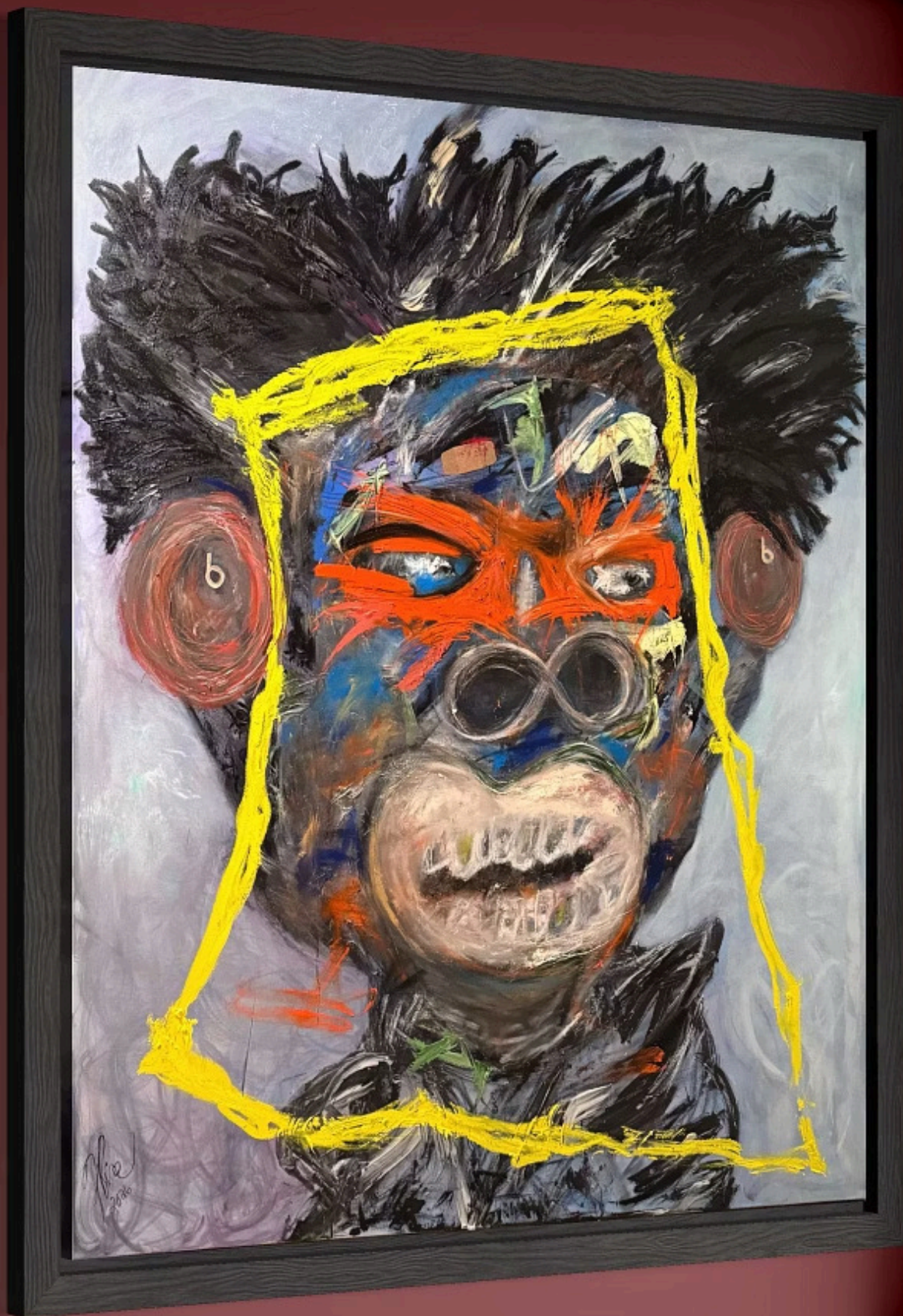

Though radiant and intuitive, she's been told to dim her light and keep her thoughts to herself. *Be Seen, Not Heard* is a bold declaration of reclaiming voice, value, and visibility. It honors those breaking free from silent spaces and stepping into full expression.

A **bright Pentacle**, luminous like a moon, hovers in the composition, offering spiritual illumination and the promise of growth when we dare to look within. Every element in this painting speaks to the idea that **the fruit is only as good as the root** — that lasting beauty and abundance must be cultivated from the inside.

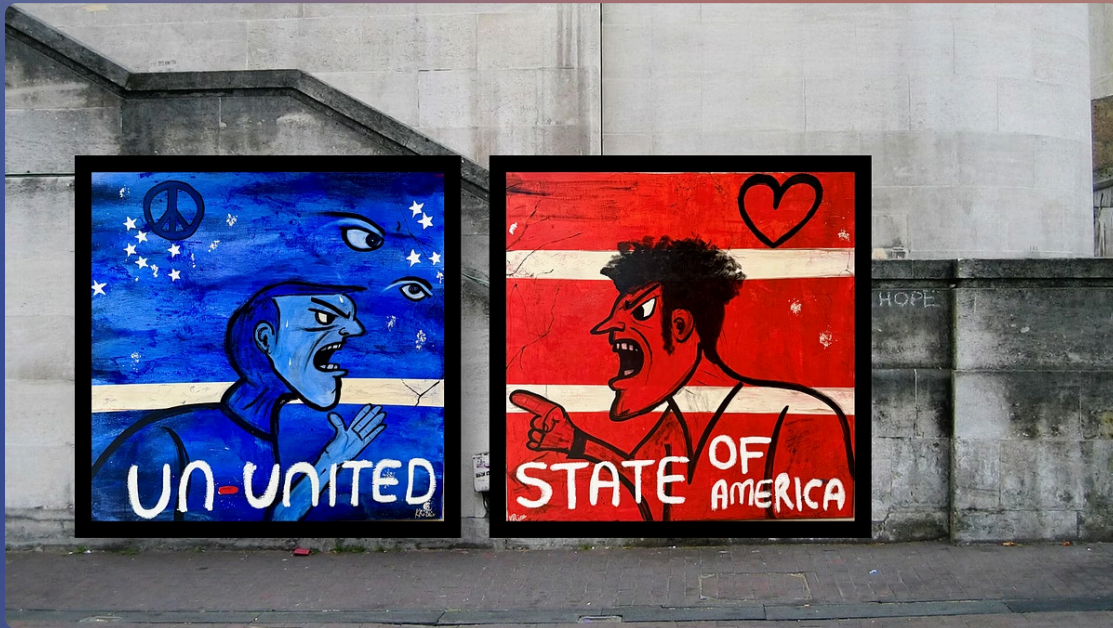

"It Was All Her Idea"

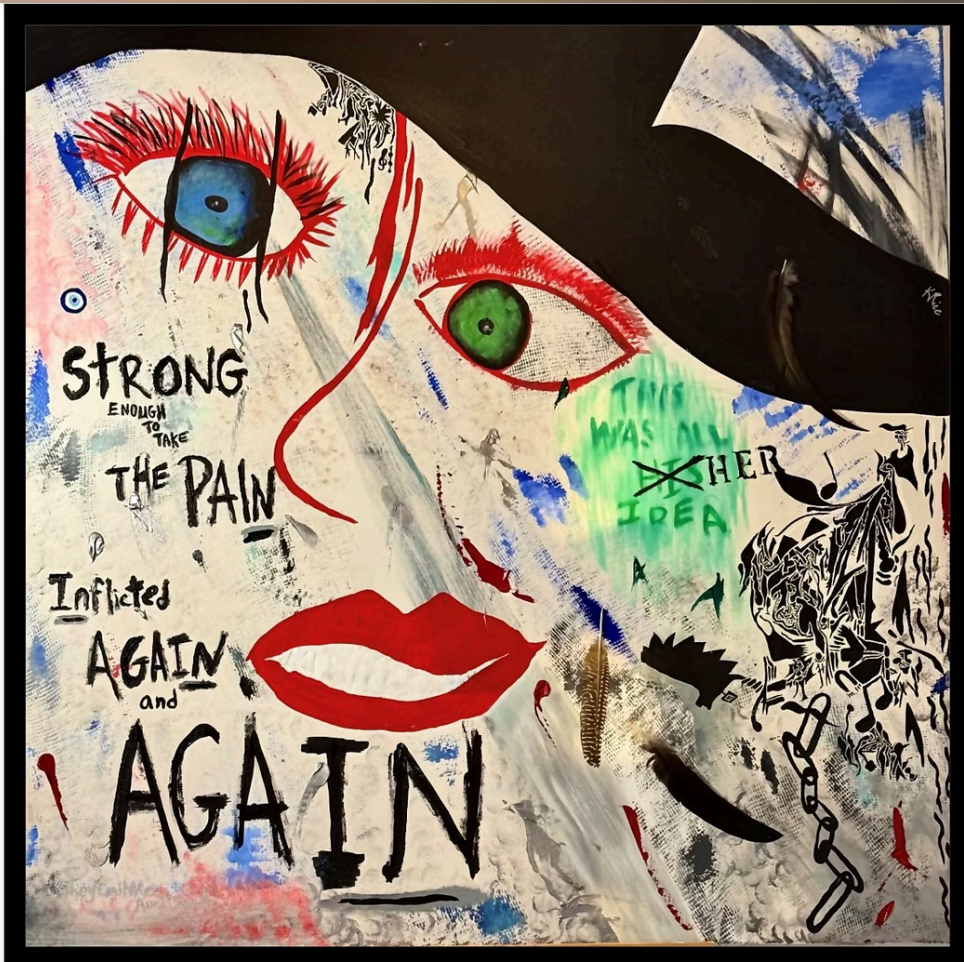

The Figure Appears Cool And Composed On The Surface, Yet His Gaze Reveals A Singular Focus — A Woman So Embedded In His Consciousness That She Exists Within Him. She Emerges Through His Eyes Like A Passageway, A Tunnel Where Thought, Fantasy, And Emotion Collapse Into One.

This Work Plays With The Idea Of Possession Versus Projection — How Attraction Can Blur Boundaries Until The Object Of Desire Lives Inside The Mind, Shaping Perception And Direction. The Bold Color Fields, Expressive Mark-Making, And Surreal Imagery Create A Sense Of Movement And Psychological Depth, Giving The Viewer A Glimpse Into A World Where Focus Becomes Fixation.

At Once Playful And Provocative, *Tunnel Vision* Invites Reflection On How Intensity Can Be Both Magnetic And Consuming.

Her Eyes Remain Hidden – Not Out Of Secrecy, But Choice – Leaving The Viewer To Question Their Own Assumptions.

She Is Loud In Style Yet Gentle In Spirit. Expressive, Fearless, And Fully Self-Possessed, She Represents The Woman Who Refuses To Dim Herself For Comfort Or Approval. Often Mistaken For Excess, She Is In Truth A High-Vibrational Soul: Stylish, Outspoken, And Deeply Authentic.

This Piece Celebrates The Courage It Takes To Be Fully Seen While Remaining Fully Misunderstood. A Reminder That Depth Cannot Always Be Measured By What Is Immediately Visible.
